# Assault-Style Firearms Compensation Program For Individual Firearm Owners Underway

The Assault-Style Firearms Compensation Program for individuals is underway. Check to see if your firearm is eligible for a buyback at [Canada.ca/firearms-compensation](https://Canada.ca/firearms-compensation).

You have until March 31, 2026, to apply for compensation.

The amnesty period ends on October 30, 2026. By then, firearms prohibited in 2020, 2024 and 2025 have to be deactivated, turned in to police or exported.

If you require assistance, a paper declaration to apply by mail, or if you would like to receive information in an Indigenous language (Mohawk, Anishinaabemowin (Ojibwe), Inuktitut (South Baffin), Cree, Algonquin, Dene, and Mi'kmaq), please contact the ASFCP Contact Centre.
